Dear Parents-

Happy March! With the turn of the calendar page, we receive assurance that spring is on its way! Each morning as I drive to school the beauty of the sunrise provides a reminder of the lengthening days and ebbing winter.

With the change of seasons, comes challenges on our playground. Next week, we ask that students still bring all their outside gear. The weather is unpredictable, and each day teachers and playground staff will make a decision on what students are asked to wear. Students will not be required to wear their items home. As the weather has begun to improve, I have noticed an increase in students being dropped off before 7:40 AM. They are congregating at the corner of our building and are not supervised. This is a safety and liability concern for us. Please do not drop your student off before 7:40 AM. Doors will not be open. Students should remain in their cars until the

patrols come out of the building. If you have a need to drop off earlier than 7:40, we have a before care program available. Please call with questions about how to access that.
